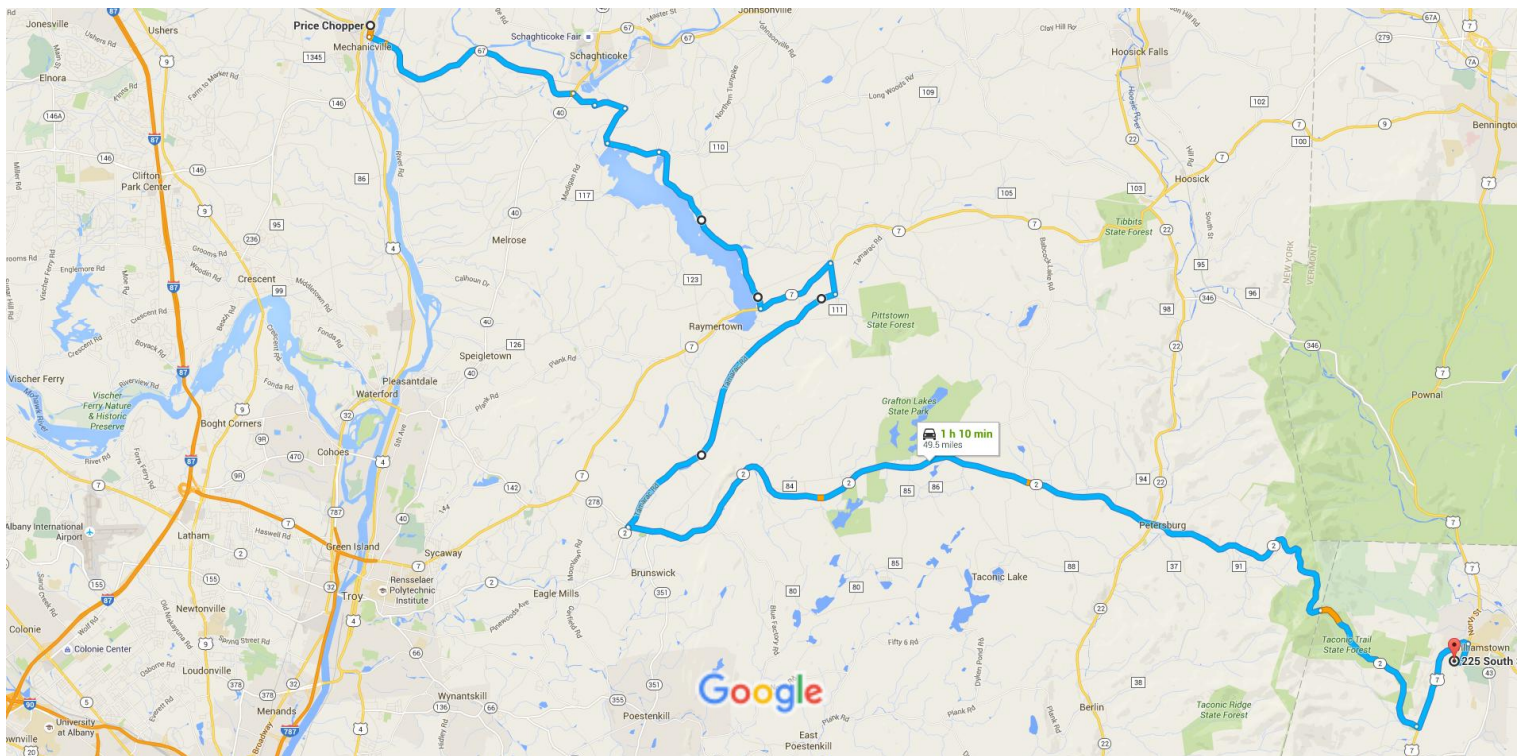


Upstate Miata day drive from Mechanicville, NY to Williamstown, MA (Clark Art Institute) - S&K Pitkin, B Ratigan

- ↖ 5. Turn left to stay on E Schaghticoke Rd 0.7 mi

- ↗ 6. Turn right onto Melrose-Valley Falls Rd 0.9 mi

- ↖ 7. Turn left onto Reservoir Rd 1.2 mi

- 8. Turn right to stay on Reservoir Rd 4.5 mi

- ⤵ 9. Turn left onto NY-7 E 1.9 mi

- 10. Turn right onto Parker School Rd 0.7 mi

- 11. Turn right onto Tamarac Rd 7.2 mi

- ⤵ 12. Turn left onto NY-278 S 121 ft

- ⤵ 13. Turn left onto NY-2 E 19.1 mi

- ↑ 14. Continue onto MA-2 E 3.8 mi

- ⤵ 15. Turn left onto US-7 N 2.4 mi

Continue on South St to your destination

The Clark Art Institute is an excellent art museum with a permanent collection that features American and European paintings, sculpture, drawings, and decorative arts from the Renaissance to the early 20th century. The collection is especially rich in French Impressionist and Academic paintings, British oil sketches, drawings, and silver.

The onsite cafe serves very good fresh lunches (soups, sandwiches, salads) which can be enjoyed outdoors at the reflecting pool or elsewhere on the grounds. The grounds also contain walking trails.

The museum is open till 5 PM.
